Treasure hunt clues

You can make a treasure hunt by creating simple clues for your family to follow. How complicated they are depends on the age of the people searching! Older children will enjoy creating their own clues.

Simplest clues:

Take photos of hiding places on your phone and print pictures of them as clues. This works well for under 5s.

You can cut out these clues and hide them with the Bible Verse Cards, or use them an inspiration to create your own clues:

Simple clues

Look near the kitchen sink.	
Look near the bottom of the stairs.	
Look near the front door.	
Look near the back door.	
Look near the bathroom door.	
Look near the letter box.	
Look under a pillow.
