What questions do you have?


CHALLENGE

Explore protection in the Bible

An intergenerational resource

Inside are eight Bible stories of people who experienced protection.

Here's a suggestion of how you could explore their stories either on your own, or with your family or small group:

1 Listen to their stories

Appoint a reader or use an audible Bible, such as those at biblegateway.com where you'll find a range of Bible translations. A favourite is the NIVUK read by David Sucket. While you are listening you might like to draw, colour, knit, play with lego or perhaps eat a snack.

2 Think and chat

Use the questions to ponder or chat with your family or church community. Let the questions start your discussion about the story, the people in it and what we might discover about our relationship with God from the story.

3 Challenge

Each story has a challenge for you to try, something to help you explore the story further or apply it in some way.
